

## Questional Behaviors (Risk)

Specific to the Entertainment Industry

		Lack of personal relationships with adults
		Manager, Agent, Publicist, Acting Coach, Photographer, Website Designer, "scout"
		Movie fan - sees lots of kid oriented movies - Disney/Nick - especially live young children
		Home / Office filled with kid-oriented things
		Collects kid movie memorabilia, autographs, headshots
		Has a dog
		Offers free headshots, does screen caps, may have access to studio publicity
		Extremely computer literate - access to computer at work , a lot of time available
		Requests to travel to set with the child, creates sleepovers, travel to pilot season or out of state auditions
		Exert's control - wardrobe, appearance - "Do this, I'll make you a star - you HAVE to use this photographer"
		This is just between us - what happens in acting class stays in acting class - method acting
		Seeks single parent families - or families where 1 parent is absent
		Meticulous planner
		Discourages parent or child from talking to other industry professionals or other parents
		Attends talent competitions, then smaller groups for management, seems to have 'favorite' kid
		Offers gifts, premieres, jobs, charity events, award nominations, industry parties, etc.
		Use of a 'retreat' - location other than home (cabin, beach house, etc)
		Teaches safety, promotes charity events, speaks out freely against others
		Blanks in employment history / background - Financial issues in the past (bankruptcies)
